Peaks, decided where to locate his new microbrewery two years ago when he was visiting a restaurant downtown.

"It was the first time I had been back here in years," said Anthony, a brewer for more than 10 years. "I was impressed with all the development taking place."

Anthony said the San Tan Brewing Company is the first independently owned and operated brewpub to open in the Valley in more than a decade. He wants his brewery to be seen as a neighborhood gathering place.

That is demonstrated by his strong ties to the business community. In fact, the glassware Anthony designed for his brewery was produced by the downtown business di Sciacca.

The brewery produces six different types of beer and serves what Anthony jokingly refers to as "upscale pub grub." This month they will begin construction on a patio on the north side that will have seating for an additional 80 people.

Hours are Sunday through Wednesday, 11 a.m. to midnight and Thursday through Saturday, 11 a.m. to 2 a.m. There's also a daily happy hour from 3 to 7 p.m. with \$5 appetizers ...and the robust beginnings of a loyal customer base.

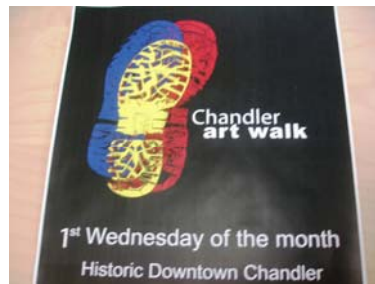
Kicks Off Oct. 13
